- 1. Individuals who are teaching children birth through age 8 (3rd grade.)
- 2. Has shown exceptional skills in teaching developmentally appropriate lessons, being an advocate for young children, and/or a thoughtful and caring relationship with children, families, and other professionals in the field.
- 3. Individuals who work directly with children in child care and early education programs.
- 4. In an effort to recognize the diversity within the field of early childhood, SDAEYC encourages applications from full-day child care centers, half-day preschool or nursery school programs, school-age child care, kindergarten and primary education, infant and toddler classrooms, in-home child care programs, home visiting programs, and classrooms serving young children with special needs.
